

Bilingual Clinician

The Children's Home of Kingston Office of Refugee Resettlement Program (ORR) is seeking a bilingual clinician to work with our client population of boys ages 10-18. This position reports to the Program Director and is responsible for providing individual, group, and family therapy to ORR children and families or sponsors, as well as consulting with other staff members and community agencies.

Qualifications

Licensed Masters Degree in Social Work (LMSW) or equivalent degree in education, psychology, sociology, or other relevant human service degree. Previous clinical experience preferred but will consider new graduates. Will also consider a MSW with 5 years of clinical related experience. License eligible clinicians are required to be actively pursuing licensure.

Job duties include:

- Conduct mental health assessments including screening for human trafficking and crisis intervention
- Provide weekly individual and group counseling
- Collaborate with Case Manager to develop family reunification goals
- Demonstrates competence in dealing with children and families from diverse cultures
- Participate in treatment team conferences and completes paperwork in a timely manner
