CHK has five residential cottages, a group home, a supervised independent living program, and an approved special education school (Grove Street Academy) that is located on our main campus. The Grove Street Academy is our campus educational facility for youths in our residential and day programs, grades 4 to 12. All teachers are NYS certified, and our school is regulated and approved by the NYS Education Department. We are currently seeking applicants for the position of Full Time NYS Certified Teacher: Grove Street Academy. The position reports to the Director of Education Services.

Specific Duties

- Provides pedagogical instruction/supervision to assigned students.
- Develops and implements lesson plans.
- Maintains Attendance Records.
- Reports grades and progress reports. Submits written Team Conference reports on schedule.
- Writes IEP goals and objectives.
- Compiles/implements relevant IEP's.
- Collaborates in concert with agency staff in the development of treatment plans for all CHK students.
- Provides individual and small group instruction in order to adapt the curriculum to the needs of pupils with varying intellectual abilities, attitudes, and cultural backgrounds.

Qualifications:

- New York State Permanent, Professional, or Initial Teaching Certification 4-6. Experience preferred; recent college graduates (who have completed student teaching requirements) or retirees are encouraged to apply.
- Energetic and inspired to actively engage with students within the framework of our school day
- Must take a Therapeutic Crisis Intervention Course, as well as a refresher course, every six months
- Master Degree preferred
- Bachelor Degree required.
- Special Education Certification is highly desirable.
- Drug Test and Background Check are required for this position
